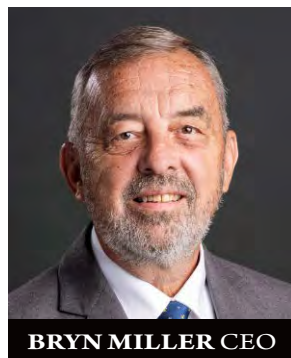

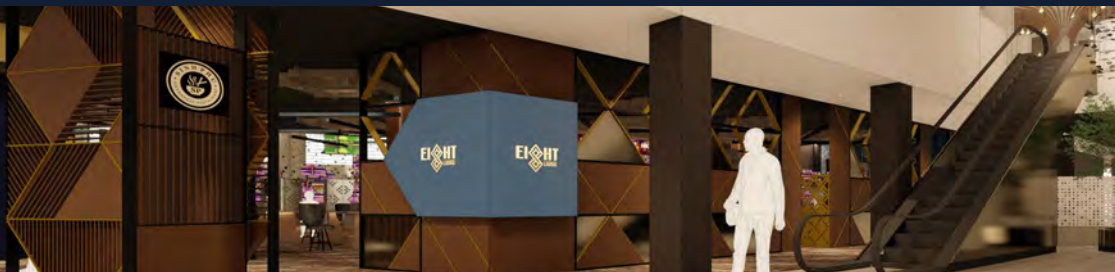
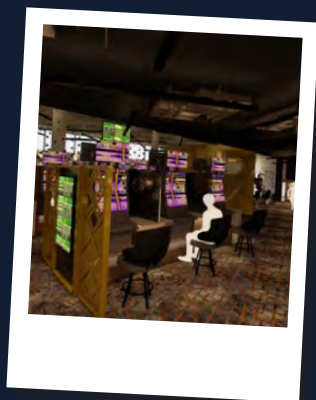

his thirty-year tenure at Merrylands RSL. The time line should have the special committee appointed by the Board, make a recommendation at the Board meeting late in March.

In more recent news, visitors to Merrylands RSL will have noticed our campaign to demonstrate to the public that our club supports all of the measures to prevent Covid spreading on our premises. We have taken the view to go over and above what is expected as the norm to prove to our patrons that we have a safe venue to visit.

Our congratulations go to Lisa Lake, the recently elected mayor of Cumberland Council. We look forward to working with you, and the newly elected Councillors in the future with our commemorative events and development of the club.

The Two Blues Rugby season kicked off on Saturday 5th February with a number of trial matches on the day at the brand new Eric Tweedale Stadium. We wish them well for the 2022 season.

# IMPORTANT HISTORICAL EVENT

## *British Commonwealth Occupation Force (BCOF)*

The BCOF totalled 45,000 personnel from Britain, India, New Zealand, and Australia. Close to 16,000 Australians served in BCOF, including Infantry, Air Force, and 130 Australian General Hospital Personnel. The Royal Navy had a presence in the region as part of the British Pacific Fleet.

The primary objective was to enforce the terms of the unconditional surrender that had ended the second World War. BCOF was required to maintain military control and supervise the demilitarisation and disposal of the remnants of Japan's war making capacity. By the end of 1946, the task of demilitarising Japan required less effort and the role of the occupying forces changed. Guard Duties and training became the main focus. The RAN component of the BCOF, with the assistance from the RAAF, was responsible for patrolling the inland sea, to prevent smuggling and illegal immigration.

At the peak of its involvement the Australian component of BCOF was responsible for every twenty million Japanese citizens and 57,000 square kilometres of country. By the end of 1948, BCOF was composed entirely of Australians. The force was dismantled on 28 April 1952 when the Japanese Peace Treaty came into effect.
